## 2013 PROJECTS IN THE WORKS

- Sidewalk Repair. Timeframe - Contract Awarded, work to start shortly.
- Replace dead or dying bushes along the perimeter wall. Timeframe - Rainy Season.
- New plants for the main The Huntingtons entryway on Enterprise and Greensprings.
- New mulch on both interior and main islands, including Greensprings Rd.

## SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING



The City of Safety Harbor is moving to single stream recycling. Huntington Trails is currently scheduled for conversion in mid to late summer. Each household will receive a 64-gallon recycling container for an expanded list of recyclables (plastics 1-7, juice and milk carton, cardboard, newspaper, mixed paper, glass, aluminum & steel). All these items will go into the big new container - no more sorting! The recyclables will be picked up in an automated way, similar to how our trash is collected. Look for more information mid year.

The CERT program provides education for disaster preparedness. It includes training in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. Using the training learned in the classroom and during exercises, CERT members can assist others in their neighborhood following an event when professional responders may not be immediately available to help.




## LOOK UP
