On behalf of the residents of Huntington Trails in Safety Harbor, the Huntington Trails Home Owners Association would like to express our objection to a site plan modification application submitted to the City of Safety Harbor by Harborside Christian Church last week.

The Huntington Trails Homeowners Association is opposed to the permitting of an access drive at Marshall Street and Greensprings Drive for Harborside Church. There is no precedence for an entry way to anything other than residences and parks along both Greensprings Drive and the eastern portion of Marshall Street. Harborside is fortunate to have large and growing attendance, the corresponding high traffic volumes belong on McMullen Booth. It is inappropriate to turn the residential Huntington Associations into a traffic reliever for McMullen Booth.

For Huntington Trail residents, in particular, the only alternate route to avoid the corner of Marshall Street and Greenspring Drive is Huntington Lane. Huntington Lane is a private road built for the use of Huntington Trail residents.

This Association is galvanized in its opposition and plans to oppose the Harborside Church Access Drive - in mass and at all levels.

Please keep us informed on the Harborside application. Thank you for your consideration.
