COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS FOR HUNTINGTON TRAILS

Boats, Cars and Trucks - ARTICLE II USE RESTRICTIONS, Section 12

No truck, trailer, boat, camper, recreational vehicle or commercial vehicle shall be parked or stored on any Lot unless it is in a garage or other vehicle enclosure our of view from the street and abutting properties; provided, however, that nothing herein shall prohibit the occasional non-recurring temporary parking of such truck, trailer, boat, camper, recreational vehicle or commercial vehicle on the premises for a period not to exceed seventy-two (72) hours in any period of thirty (30) days. Street Parking Restrictions

Signs – ARTICLE II USE RESTRICTIONS, Section 3

No sign or billboard of any kind shall be displayed to the public view on any portion of any Lot, except one (1) sign for each building site, of not more than eighteen inches (18") by twenty-four inches (24"), advertising the property for sale or rent, except as approved by the Architecture Committee.
