- Alterations to the structure of the home including painting, roof replacement, fence or paver installation.

**Safety Harbor Public Works Quarterly Clean-up Schedule:**

✔ Spring Clean-Up: March 9–11

✔ Hurricane Prep Clean-Up: June 8–10

Important Guidelines:

- ✔ Collection occurs only once during the clean-up cycle.
- ✔ Place items at the curb by 6:30 AM on your regular collection day.
- ✔ Items must be bundled, bagged, or boxed, weighing less than 40 lbs, and limited to 30 items.
- ✘ No construction debris.
